It was a lovely day filled with warmth, celebration and community spirit, and one that will be remembered fondly by everyone who attended.

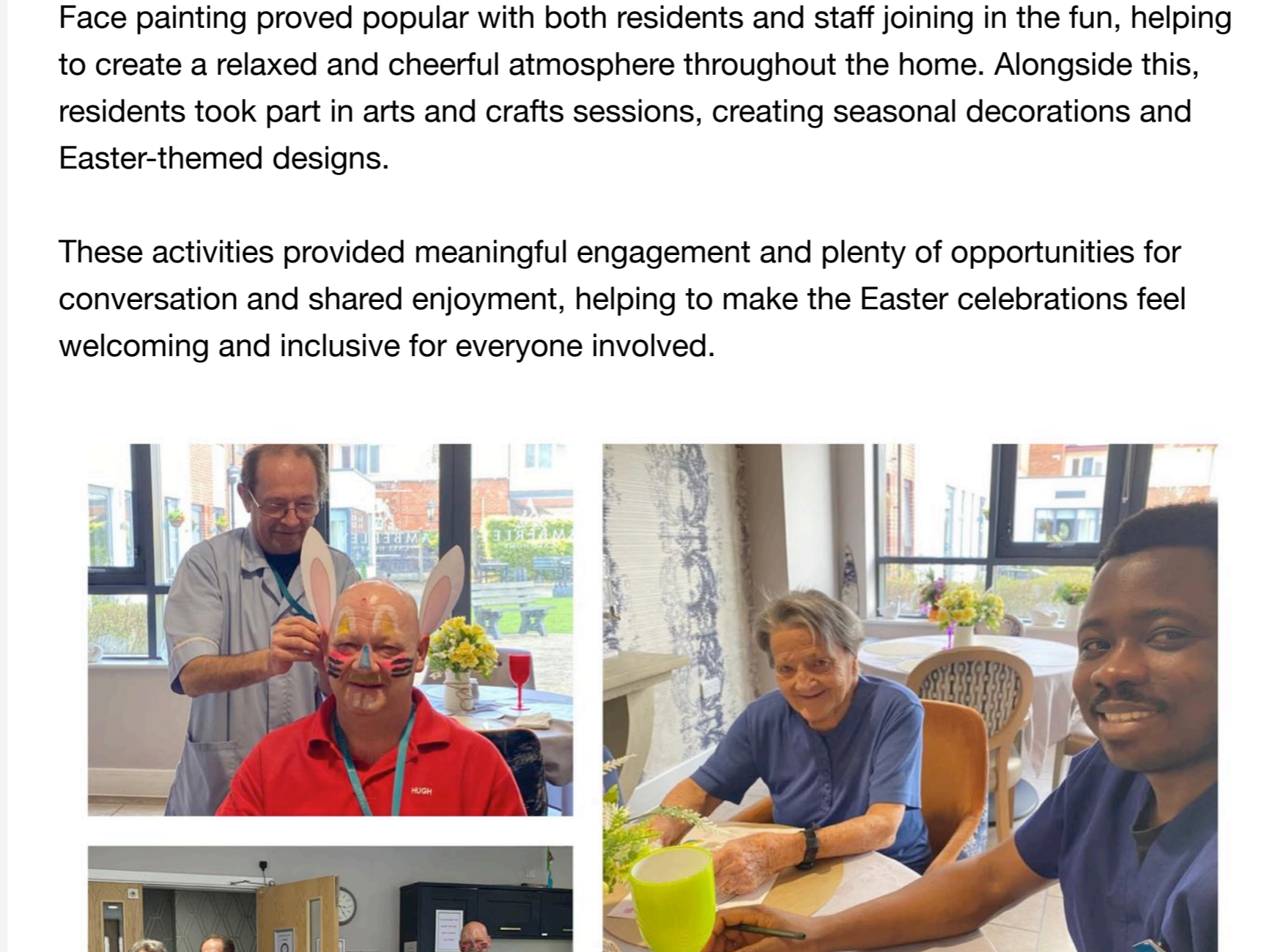


Easter Weekend

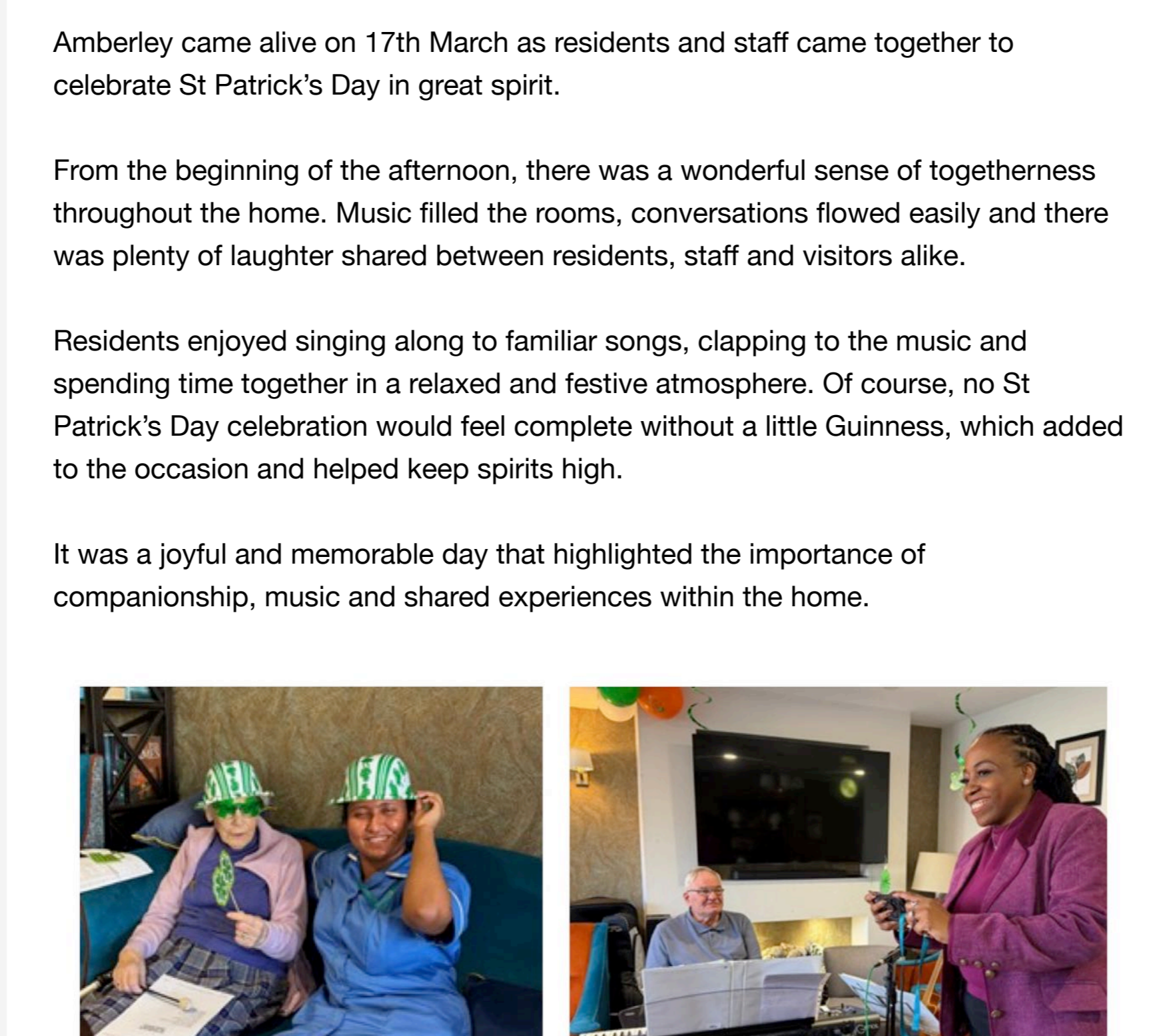
St Patrick's Day

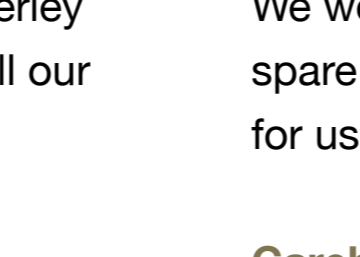
