It has been particularly nice to see residents enjoying these different experiences together, whether joining in with a larger celebration or simply sitting with friends for an afternoon of conversation.

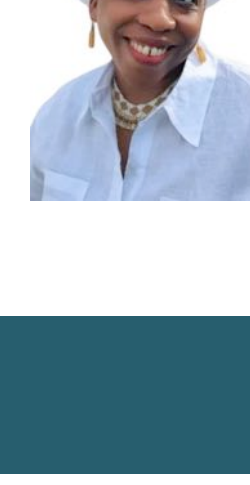
Thank you to our residents, families, friends and team for their continued support and involvement in life at Amberley. We hope you enjoy looking back at some of our recent highlights.

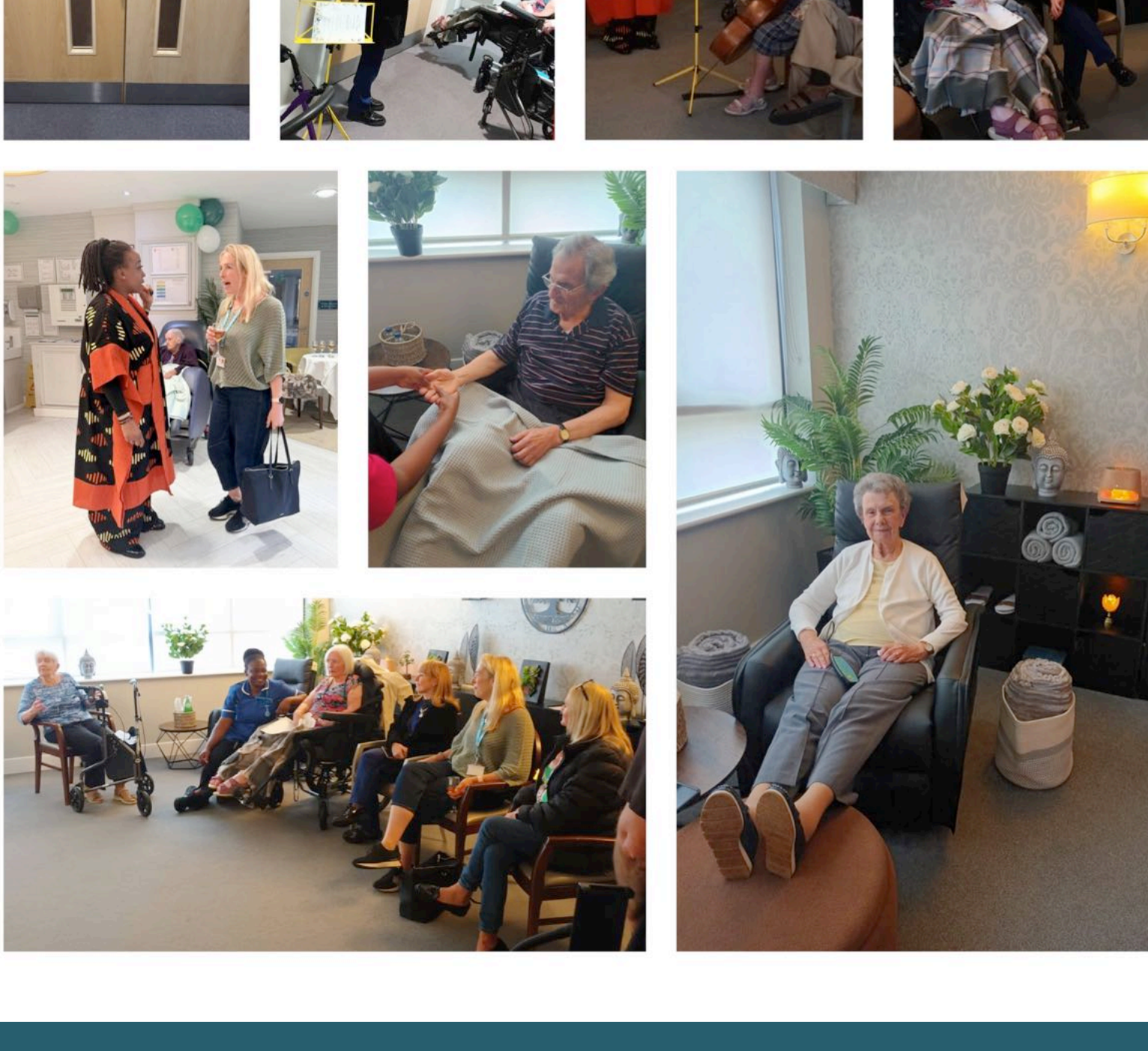
Introducing Our New Therapy Lounge

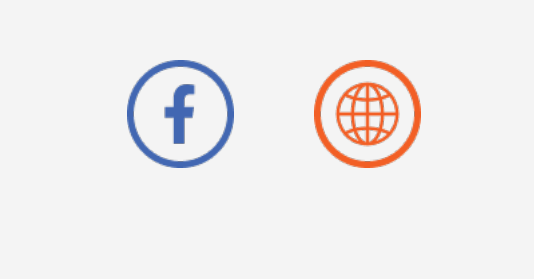

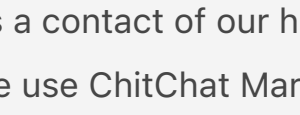
